



**ACBRI appointed Registered Service Provider by Victorian Government

MELBOURNE—In December 2017, the Victorian Government appointed the Australia-China Belt and Road Initiative (ACBRI) as a Registered Service Provider (RSP) for Victoria's Asia Gateway Voucher Program.

ACBRI will now provide strategy setting, market development planning, and in-market support services to Asia Gateway voucher recipients.
